Student groups from Thomas Jefferson High School including the TJHS Jazz Band, JROTC & Lassos Drill Teams, TJHS Choral Group will be present and providing entertainment.

This event is free and open to the public.

Dr. Sharon Skrobarcek, President of Alamo Mission Chapter, will acknowledge descendants of Texas Declaration of Independence signers. She will also recognize alumni of Thomas Jefferson High School.
